

# Past Tense Fragestellung/Verneinung

## Fragestellung mit "did"

Bildung:

**"did" + Subjekt + Infinitiv**

Beispiele:

He went to the cinema last week. → **Did** he **go** to the cinema last week?

She drank a coke yesterday. → **Did** she **drink** a coke yesterday?

## Fragestellung mit "was", "were", "could"

Bei "was", "were" und "could" darf kein "did" verwendet werden.

Bildung:

**"to be" + Subjekt**

Beispiele:

He **was** in Paris last year. → **Was** he in Paris last year?

They **were** tired yesterday. → **Were** they tired yesterday?

She **could** drive home alone. → **Could** she drive home alone?

## Fragestellung mit Fragewörtern:

Bildung:

**Fragewort + "did" + Subjekt + Infinitiv**

Beispiele:

He watched TV yesterday evening. → When **did** he **watch** TV?

She met him at the cinema last week. → Where **did** she **meet** him last week?

## Verneinung:

a) Bildung mit did:

**Subjekt + "did" + "not" + Infinitiv** z.B. I didn't drink.

a) Bildung mit was/were/could:

**Subjekt + "was/were/could" + "not"** z.B. I wasn't. They weren't. She couldn't.
