



Bildung:

Das Modalverb "dürfen" wird im Englischen mit "to be allowed to" gebildet.

Beispielsatz in allen Zeiten:

Present Simple: He **is allowed to** go to the cinema.

Past Simple: He **was allowed to** go to the cinema.

Present Perfect: He **has been allowed to** go to the cinema.

Past Perfect: He **had been allowed to** go to the cinema.

Will-Future: He **will be allowed to** go to the cinema.

Going to- Future: He **is going to be allowed to** go to the cinema.

Verneinung:

Present Simple: He **isn't allowed to** go to the cinema.

Past Simple: He **wasn't allowed to** go to the cinema.

Present Perfect: He **hasn't been allowed to** go to the cinema.

Past Perfect: He **hadn't been allowed to** go to the cinema.

Will-Future: He **won't be allowed to** go to the cinema.

Going to- Future: He **isn't going to be allowed to** go to the cinema.

Fragen:

Present Simple: **Is** he **allowed to** go to the cinema?

Past Simple: **Was** he **allowed to** go to the cinema?

Present Perfect: **Has** he **been allowed to** go to the cinema?

Past Perfect: **Had** he **been allowed to** go to the cinema?

Will-Future: **Will** he **be allowed to** go to the cinema?

Going to- Future: **Is** he **is going to be allowed to** go to the cinema?
