



Bildung:

Das Modalverb "dürfen" wird im Englischen mit "to be allowed to" gebildet.

Beispielsatz in allen Zeiten:

Present Simple: He is allowed to go to the cinema.

Past Simple: He was allowed to go to the cinema.

Present Perfect: He has been allowed to go to the cinema.

Past Perfect: He had been allowed to go to the cinema.

Will-Future: He will be allowed to go to the cinema.

Going to-Future: He is going to be allowed to go to the cinema.

Verneinung:

Present Simple: He isn't allowed to go to the cinema.

Past Simple: He wasn't allowed to go to the cinema.

Present Perfect: He hasn't been allowed to go to the cinema.

Past Perfect: He hadn't been allowed to go to the cinema.

Will-Future: He won't be allowed to go to the cinema.

Going to-Future: He isn't going to be allowed to go to the cinema.

Fragen:

Present Simple: Is he allowed to go to the cinema?

Past Simple: Was he allowed to go to the cinema?

Present Perfect: Has he been allowed to go to the cinema?

Past Perfect: Had he been allowed to go to the cinema?

Will-Future: Will he be allowed to go to the cinema?

Going to-Future: Is he is going to be allowed to go to the cinema?
